ADMISSION PROCEDURES

- To enter the camp program, all Junior Highs must have completed grade 7 or 8
- **A maximum of 25** Junior Highs will be accepted on a first come first serve basis
- Bridlegrove Day Camp has the right to refuse children to come to camp if they become an endangerment to themselves or others or if the counselors are unable to manage the child while at camp.
- Registration and application forms should be completed and returned ASAP!
- A **\$30.00 summer camp** pre-registration fee or a family rate of \$50.00 for two or more children (which is non-refundable) must accompany the application form to register. This covers the cost of a camp T-shirt, administration costs as well as reserves a space for your child/children. Please note that the pre-registration fee is not part of the camper's weekly fee.

FEES

- **\$165.00/week**

Fees are to be paid on the Monday of each week you child is attending camp.

**** In the memo please indicate the child's name and the week you are paying for!!**

- Camp hours are 8:30a.m. - 6:00pm. Early hours are available from 8:00a.m. - 8:30a.m. at an additional cost of **\$10.00** flat rate per week. Cash is to be left with a counselor each Monday.
- Fees include a field trip as well as two snacks per day
- Fees **do not** include lunch. Campers must bring their own lunch
- We are a **NUT FREE** day camp. Please **DO NOT INCLUDE ANY TYPE OF NUTS IN YOUR CHILD'S LUNCH**

ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

- **Day Camp hours are 8:30a.m. - 6:00p.m.**
- If your child is walking /traveling to and from camp on their own, a letter is to be attached to their camp forms. This letter must state that the camp may release your child at a specific time each day and that you are confident that your child is dependable and responsible to safely get to and from camp on their own. Also, that he/she has access to a neighbor or a person he/she knows and their phone numbers, in the

case of an emergency when they leave the camp premises. Please include their names and numbers in this letter. Please sign and date this form to acknowledge that you are allowing your child to travel to and from Bridle Grove Day Camp.

- Any parent picking up a camper after 6:00 p.m. will be charged a **late fee** which is payable to the counselor attending your child upon pick-up. A late book is to be signed at this time. The fee is \$1.00 for every minute you are late.

- A Parent or Guardian must sign their child in and out each day on the attendance sheet

- Be sure to notify the camp if an alternate person will be picking up your child. No child will be released to any other person without the parent's written or verbal consent

- **the day camp location is closed when an off location trip is scheduled**

SPECIAL NEEDS

The term Special Needs encompasses a rather wide range of specific types of Individual needs. The following considerations will clearly indicate the actual types of "Special Needs" children that we would enroll into our Camp Program:

a) The experience level of our camp counselors

b) Child/staff ratio, group size

c) Age groupings

d) Program Goals

e) If the family has a worker that joins the child at camp

Bridle Grove will only agree to serve families whose children's total developmental needs can be safely and realistically met in our fast paced, busy, fun filled camp program.

ALLERGIES AND HEALTH

Children with any type of serious health problem or allergy must wear a Medic Alert Bracelet. This will be a good reminder as well as a tool to help our staff to keep track of various needs within their group. All health conditions must be recorded on the application form as well as verbally reported to the counselors upon their first day of camp.

MEDICATION

Please see a camp counselor if your child is on medication and they will give you a medication release form to complete. Please do not leave any medication in your child's possession but leave it with a camp counselor. Only prescription medication or medication accompanied by a doctor's note will be administered.

ILLNESS

If your child is not feeling well day or night with fever, diarrhea, vomiting etc. keep your child/children home. They must be symptom free for 24hrs, before returning to camp. Camp is unable to accommodate a sick child. If your child becomes ill during the day we will contact you and it is the parent's responsibility to come as soon as possible or make alternate pick up arrangements.

BANQUET

What a wonderful way to conclude our summer day camp program. Remember to mark Thursday, August 24, 2023 on your calendar. This is an exciting event that you don't want to miss! The banquet is held on the last day of camp at 6:00pm. It is a fun filled evening for the whole family. Your children look forward to this event all summer. It's a time for them to receive awards, show off what they have learned, entertain you and enjoy dinner with all their friends and say good-bye.
